This led to becoming a referee and coach. He was introduced to Futsal eventually and was inspired to learn more. Fast forward to now and Kevin has been involved in Futsal with the FA, with FIFA and has developed the game hugely on a local level too.

Kevin now runs the Grimsby Futsal League which has now seen 3 of it's players play for England and a referee achieve FIFA recognition. Futsal opened doors for them to travel to Japan; Malaysia and numerous other European countries.

Futsal demands a very high level of mental fitness and physical strength and over 20 years of the League has increased the well-being of an awful lot of people. More than that it has created a lot of sporting opportunity.

Kevin reflects upon his own journey and says that he has had endless hours and pleasure from coaching and observing futsal and made numerous friends at both grassroots and international level.

He is also complimentary of the support he has received from officers at the County FA:
