## Do's and Don'ts

### for litter champions and community clean-ups

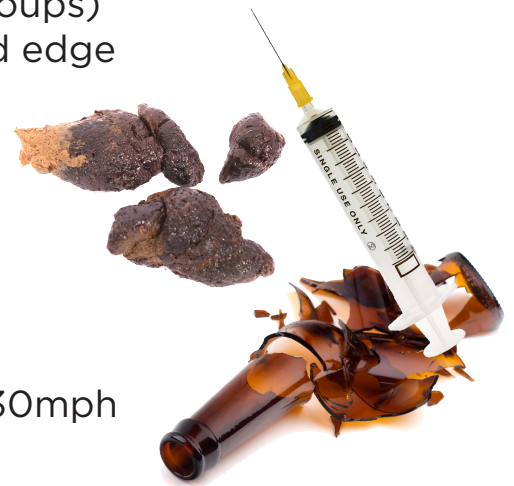


## DO:

- Always use a litter picker
- Wear the gloves provided for cleanliness purposes but remember these will not protect you from sharp objects
- Wash your hands thoroughly after litter picking and once again before eating
- Make sure an adult is supervising children taking part in the litter pick at all times
- Wear the high visibility jackets/waistcoats provided
- Stay on the paths at all times
- Observe current government Covid restrictions and guidance (including social distancing and meeting in groups)
- Keep at least 1.5 metres away from active road edge
- Work facing oncoming traffic
- Work in clear daylight only

## DON'T:

- Pick from in the road
- Pick from roads with speed limit in excess of 30mph
- Pick litter up with your hands



## DON'T PICK UP ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Glass, Hypodermic needle/syringes, dog mess, asbestos or any sharp objects
