



ECO Flex: Householder Application Form

ECO Flex allows local authorities to extend the eligibility criteria of the Energy Company Obligation (ECO4) scheme. This form allows households to apply to **Boston Borough Council** for the ECO Flex scheme as detailed in the Statement of Intent on the website: https://www.boston.gov.uk/ECO4. Households are able to indicate on this form which of the four available routes they may qualify under and share their personal details with their local authority or eligibility assessor.

All potentially eligible households should apply through Boston Borough Council, YES Energy Solutions or Everwarm Ltd to ensure that they can either benefit from the scheme or be assessed for eligibility under any other relevant programme.
