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Herbert Protocol  Smart Wristbands	The Herbert Protocol is a national scheme which has been launched in Lincolnshire and encourages carers and families to record vital information on a form which could be used in the event of a vulnerable person going missing.  A "smart" wristband can be issued to people living with dementia. The wristband stores the name and contact details of a wearer's next of kin so that if someone gets lost, police or members of the public can quickly access contact details by placing a mobile phone against the device. Please note, the wristband is not a tracker.  If you're a carer or relative of someone who is living with dementia you can request a wristband when you complete the Herbert Protocol form.
